You will be aware that the National Education Union (NEU) have declared national strike action on Wednesday 1st February 2023, which will impact significantly on all schools.

Having risk assessed the situation, **Stepney All Saints School will be closed on Wednesday 1st February.**

A small number of students from all year groups will be invited in, where we feel that they would benefit from additional study support on this day. We will contact you if this involves your child. If you have not been contacted, please do not send your child in to school on this day.

Students in all year groups are expected to maintain a routine and use this day as an opportunity to complete any outstanding homework and pre-learning activities for lessons.
